With that in mind they established the **EITSA Tairawhiti** Endowment Fund to protect and grow this legacy for future generations of students in the Tairawhiti region.

Any donation you make will be invested, protected and grown each year in line with inflation. The surplus investment income will be granted back to **EITSA Tairawhiti** every year, for them to distribute as scholarships to Tairawhiti students, meaning your donation will keep supporting tertiary students in our region forever.
